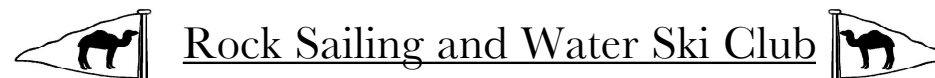

When additional briefings are required they will be held 75 minutes before the start time except the Quayside Trophy will be 90 minutes

IMPORTANT RULES

1/ **The Start** - Windward boat must keep clear and has no overlap entitlement at the start.

2/ **Overlap at three boat lengths** - Water may be called at three clear boat lengths when approaching a mark.

3/ **Windward Boat** to keep clear at all times.

4/ **Boat on Starboard Tack** has right of way with close hauled having total rights.

5/ **Infringements** - Always 720 degrees with the exception of hitting a buoy when you must do 360 degrees, in both instances as soon as possible but away from other craft.

6/ **AVOID COLLISIONS AT ALL COSTS THEN PROTEST IF NECESSARY. YOU MUST NOTIFY THE OFFENDING BOAT AT THE TIME THAT YOU INTEND TO PROTEST AN ALLEGED INFRINGEMENT.**

Now protests are much more informal and held in the bar after the race providing useful learning opportunities.
