



Rock Sailing and Water Ski Club Provisional Summer Schedule 2021

29th March 21

Recreational boating can be restarted subject to PHC consent. Indications are that it may be allowed from the 12 April. This is waiting on Department of Transport approval.

The Club will remain shut.

12th April 21

Club can reopen for outdoor service (subject to weather of course).

Outdoor hospitality can start under Rule of 6, or 2 households maximum per table.

No indoor mixing will be allowed so changing rooms cannot be used.

Table service only for both food and drink.

Social contact rules must continue to be abided by and staff will be tested regularly.

WETA Open (1st - 3rd May)

Participants cannot use clubhouse but can, subject to the above rules, eat and drink outside. Disabled toilet will be open.

17th May 2021

30 person groups limit outdoors. Gatherings of more than 30 people outdoors will remain illegal.

Rule of 6 or 2 households indoors. Indoor hospitality including drinks only. Requirement to order, eat and drink whilst remaining seated. Remember to keep your yellow Club card with you to benefit from members' discounts.

The Government is expected to update advice on social distancing between friends and family as data allow. Until then people should continue to keep recommended social distancing from anyone not in their household or support bubble.

Spring Cup (29th – 31st May), Spring Fling (21st – 24th May), and Larks Nationals (30th May – 2nd June).

The Government is due to update advice after 17th May and until then says social distancing must remain. The shower rooms will be opened as soon as guidance allows.

21st June 2021

No legal limits on social contact.

Club fully open.

If the situation continues to improve, Shrimper Week (18th – 23rd June) should not be greatly affected and we can hold our first club supper if required.

Unless the situation deteriorates, both Camel Week (13th – 20th August) and Junior Camel Week (29th July – 5th August) look likely to continue.
